WHAT ARE THE PRECAUTIONS FOR NEWLY PURCHASED LASER CUTTING MACHINES

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When purchasing a laser cutting machine, many customers may pay more attention to the price, operating skills, and how to achieve the desired cutting effect of the laser cutting machine. They often ignore the precautions before using new equipment. Below, we will explain how to better use the laser cutting machine.

Laser cutting machine

Acceptance: First, check whether the equipment is purchased by yourself, whether there is any damage to the equipment during transportation, and whether the relevant components and accessories of the equipment are complete and undamaged. If there are transportation damages, inconsistent laser cutting machine models, missing components, etc., it is necessary to contact after-sales personnel for verification and handling.

- 2. Location and installation requirements for laser cutting machines: Choose a dry, damp, well ventilated place with sufficient space to place the equipment. In order to ensure cutting quality, it is necessary to keep away from vibration. The ground on which the equipment is placed should be flat. After being placed in a suitable location, the equipment should be reinforced.
- 3. Equipment debugging: The manufacturer will debug the relevant parameters of the newly purchased equipment, but the transportation needs to re split the equipment and the road is bumpy. After arriving at the destination, the equipment needs to be reinstalled and debugged.
 - **4. After sales training:** After the equipment arrives, professional after-sales engineers will provide training on equipment operation, such as equipment installation, parameter adjustment, daily maintenance, and other related precautions.

If the equipment fails during use, it is necessary to contact the manufacturer as soon as possible. Do not handle uncertain issues by yourself to avoid causing secondary damage to the equipment.
